

Press Release – Prestige Masters Series Final 2021

The seventh Prestige Masters Series Final was held last Saturday at India's #1 ranked golf course, Prestige Golfshire Club.

This year's event saw 650 golfers compete over 4 qualifying legs for a place in the final.

This year's final comprised of 60 players competing for the coveted accolades of being the 2021 Masters Series Champion and also winning a trip for two flying Emirates Business Class to the Troon Golf Managed, Costa Navarino Westin Resort & Spa in Greece. The prize for two persons includes golf on the acclaimed Bernhard Langer and Jose Maria Olazabal golf courses.

This year's winner qualified in the 3rd leg in September. Mr Ashok Chokalingan won the event by five shots from Satyendra Kumar.

Mr Chokalingan was ecstatic with his win and stated that it was the highlight of his golfing life.

The Prestige Golfshire Team worked tirelessly to have the course ready to play after the course experienced over 2" of rain on the Thursday night before the event, causing the 7th green to disappear under water for most of Friday. But by Saturday the green was visible again and open for play.
