Last week the US Women's Amateur Championship was played at the Bandon Dunes Resort in Oregon and Stanford University standout Meghna Ganne came up trumps winning this prestigious event. Meghna parents moved to the US from India before she was born. The New Jersey native has been a force in women's amateur golf in the US for some time and made headlines in 2021 when she led the US Women's Open as a 17-year-old qualifier. Although she did not end up winning the event her name and golf game became very well known and respected globally.

The Fed Ex Cup wraps up next week and it is beginning to feel like Scottie Scheffler's name should just be engraved on every trophy each week with another win this past weekend at the BMW Championship.

After winning the British Open at Portrush in July he only requires one more win, the US Open to complete the Grand Slam which Rory McIlroy just completed in April of this year when he won the Masters Tournament. It took McIlroy nearly 14 years to complete the Grand Slam, Scheffler may do it in 5 years if he can win the US Open next year at Shinnecock Hills on Long Island.

The Ryder Cup gets under way next month at Bethpage Black on Long Island. With the very patriotic NY crowds in attendance it is going to be hard for the European team to stay focused over the 3 days of competition. On paper the Europeans may have a better team but the home game advantage for the US team will certainly prove to be a challenge for Luke Donald and his team. The Ryder Cup begins Sept 23-25.

Keep an eye out for more new events this year at Golfshire including the EZGO Seniors Open in December over two days. This will be open to both male and female golfers over the age of 50 years at the time of the event.

Cauliflower and Walnut Soup

INGREDIENTS

- 1 head cauliflower (about 1/2kg), cut into bite-size florets
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- salt n black pepper
- 1 stick celery
- 1 medium red onion, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 3 4 cups vegetable broth
- 1 tablespoons butter

HOW TO PREPARE

- Heat 2 tablespoon olive oil in a deep saucepan.
- Add onion, garlic and celery cook until soft.
- Add cauliflower and vegetable stock. Season with a little salt and pepper. Cook for about 20 minutes, or until cauliflower get soft.
- Once cauliflower get soft then remove from heat.
- in blender to blend until smooth, you may need to do this in batches. Return pureed soup to the saucepan, check the seasoning add fresh cream, butter. Bring back up to heat to serve.
- Serve topped with a sprinkle of finely chopped parsley, walnut.
