Terms & Conditions

Event Cancellation & Inclement Weather Policy

Events can be rescheduled. Teams registered for events that are cancelled for any reason will be offered the opportunity to play another day. Entry fees will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Terms for Submission of Entry:

Player registering to enter these events agrees to the Official Rules. All registrants agree to Prestige Golf shire terms and conditions.

Rules of Play

The event shall be conducted in accordance with rules of R & A in conjunction with local rules of the Prestige Golf shire Club.

Interpretation of Conditions of Play

The Tournament Committee comprising of Prestige Golf shire Club will be the sole authority to interpret the conditions for this competition and to give decisions on any query, which may arise out of them. Any matter not covered under the conditions of play will be decided and its decision will be final & binding on all participants. Prestige Golf shire Club also reserves the right to fix/alter starting times.

Draw and Score Card Submission

- It is the responsibility of the individual Player to find out his/her starting time from the Golf shop. All players are required to register at the Registration Desk no less than 30 mins prior to the Shotgun Start. Any player having not registered by 30 mins prior will lose their tee time to a player on the waiting list who is present.
- A scorecard is deemed official once the Player leaves the scoring area + the card has been signed.
- Players are reminded of their responsibilities under Rule 6-6b which states:-"Signing and Returning Card: After completion of the round, the competitor should check their score for each hole and settle any doubtful points with Marker. They shall ensure that the marker has signed the card, countersign the card themselves and return within 15 minutes of completion of the round.

Award Ceremony/Prizes/Ties

- Prize distribution ceremony will be held within 1 ½ hours of the completion of play.
- In the event of a tie or ties for first place, there will be "Count Back" where The best score on the 18th hole shall be used; if there is still a tie the last 3 holes scores will be used, or if still tied the last 6 holes and so on.
- By entering these Tournaments, I agree to receive emails from Prestige Golf shire Club regarding the event, i.e. tee times, and other tournament updates.
- All players will use their full handicap as given to PGC during registration.

Note:

- Professional Golfers, Junior Players, Teaching Professionals and Touring Amateurs or Amateurs who have competed in Professional Tour Events as an Amateur, are not Eligible to win prizes or qualify for the finals.
- All players qualifying for the final will play off their deducted handicap they qualified with.
- Handicap would not be increased even if requested for the Finals
- All GPS devices are allowed to be used during the event.
- Players qualifying for the Grand Finale will not be allowed to participant in other qualifiers.
- Please verify your scores with your marker before submitting your score card, once a score card is posted no scores will be altered.

Other Information

- All events will be conducted in accordance with the rules of golf and such local rules as approved by the Tournament Committee.
- In the event that weather conditions prevent all players from finishing their round, that competition round will be cancelled and the Championship reduced accordingly. No refunds will be provided for cancelled championship rounds.
- Functions: In the event of inclement weather alternative arrangements will be made.
- The Tournament Committee may arrange media promotion and publicity before, during and after the tournament. All competitors consent to event pictures of them appearing and being used for event promotion.
- The Tournament Committee may at its discretion amend or add any condition of the tournament.
- By registering online and accepting the tournaments terms & conditions, competitors
 agree to participate in the Prestige Masters Series at their own risk. The Tournament

 accept no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred during or
